



Bus Etiquette and Safety

For your Safety

- We embrace the concept of a respectful work place and view Safety as a value. Please be considerate of each other and the driver – Derogatory, profane or threatening comments or behaviour, including **verbal abuse towards other passengers or the driver, will not be tolerated**
- **Do not approach or crowd a moving bus** (Stay at least 3 metres away from the bus until it has stopped)
- Do not open bus luggage bins on your own - Ask the driver for assistance
- Passengers disembarking should walk to the nearest corner or walkway prior to crossing streets
- **Do not** cross in front of the bus at any time. Wait until bus has moved forward to cross. Always be aware of your surroundings when walking around or waiting for a bus
- **Don't forget to buckle up.** Seatbelts are to be worn at all times as directed by your employer
- Use 3 point contact on and off the bus – **use the handrails** and watch your step
- Carry your brief case, back pack, etc. in front of you when you are walking in the aisle
- Keep aisles clear to prevent any tripping hazards
- Report any mechanical concerns to your driver
- Smoking is prohibited on the bus
- Make yourself familiar with the emergency exits of the bus

Respect/Etiquette/Comfort

- ID must be swiped or presented, or letter from your contractor as a new hire must be presented to the driver before getting on the coach (As required by contractor or site)
- **Respectfully** ask your driver to adjust the heat or air conditioning
- **Be Courteous and have respect for everyone riding the bus**
- Please use the designated garbage or remove your waste from the bus
- Only 1 seat per person. Do not save seats.
- Place your brief case, back pack, etc. in the overhead bins or under the seat in front of you.
- Please be aware of other passengers individual space, don't take up more room within the seats than needed
- The driver will only stop at designated stops
- Do not put your feet on the seats
- **Do not** wear any dirty or contaminated coveralls or clothing on the bus
- Do not wear excessive perfume or deodorant, others may be allergic
- Keep volumes of electronic devices to a minimum
- Keep cell phone conversations short & quiet
- Individuals who violate, cause, or participate in a disturbance are subjective to corrective action, including suspension or termination of busing and site privileges
